


Changes in the Russian Civil Code

90% of corporate deals today can be done under Russian law, which now provides the same instruments as English law.






Regulation of the Profession - TBC



The legal profession in Russia remains unregulated with the exception of 'advocates'




Mix of corporate legal work







Premium work is shrinking as a proportion




Is the legal market becoming more competitive?
